How soon can I get my 1st ride?

During the pilot phase, registration began March 6th and rides will be available from April 1 thru June 30, 2017

How much will it cost?

Rides are \$5 each way within a 15 mile radius. Cost includes 1 or more riders. If you go beyond the service area, regular rates apply.

Where can I go?

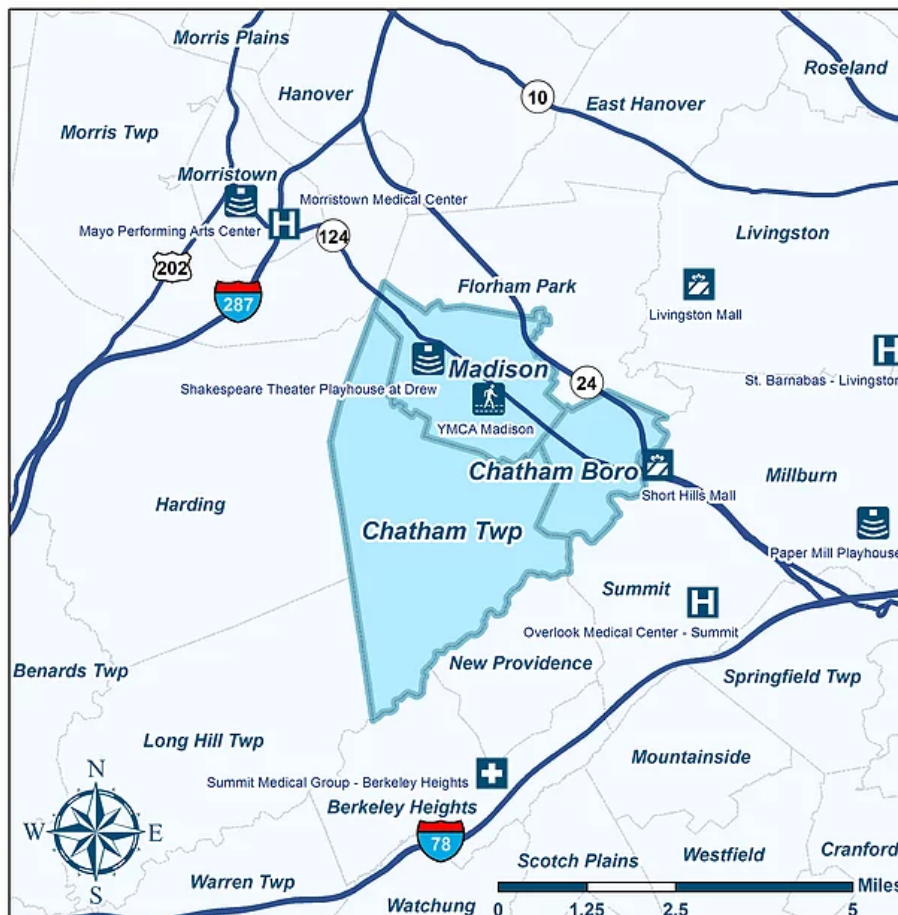
Whether it's for medical appointments, shopping or entertainment...there are so many places to visit within our service area! See map below.
